

## LSAT Lab Diagnostic Instructions

Signing up for LSAT Lab will automatically open the platform, but before you can access the Diagnostic Practice Test, you'll need to verify your email. Go to your inbox and open the email from LSAT Lab with the subject line "Verify your email address" and follow the instructions. If you don't see the email in your inbox, check your Spam/Promotions folder. Once you're verified and signed into the LSAT Lab platform, follow the instructions below!

If you happen to have signed up for LSAT Lab before June 15, 2024, you may see the 1-94 numbering system in your dropdown menu. To fix this and get the new 100+ system, click the icon in the upper right corner by your name . Select "Settings" and toggle on the "No LG" setting.

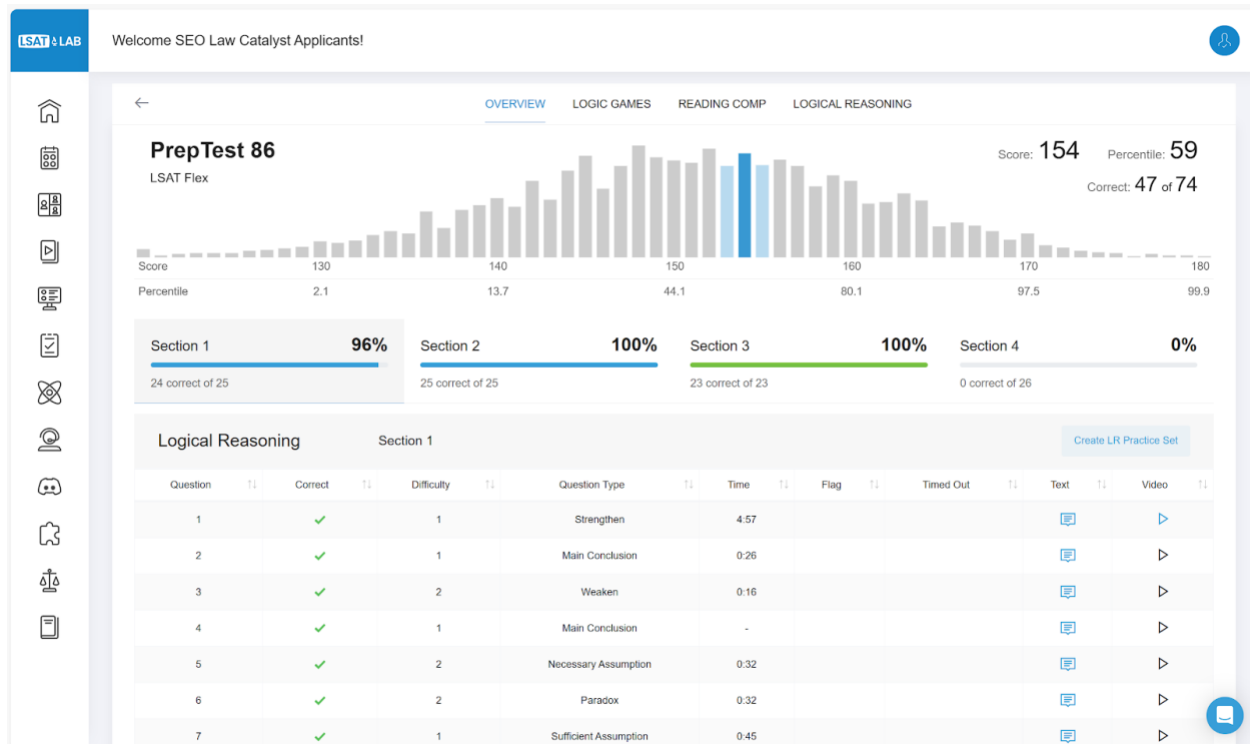
